Functions

Normal	Red LED flashes once (48 seconds); Green LED is always on	●○ 48 ●●●●●■×
Fault	Buzzer sound every 48 seconds (indicating a fault)	4 , 48
Low Power	Buzzer sound every 48 seconds; Accompanied by yellow LED flash	•○ 48 ◄ ,
Alarm	Pulsating buzzer; Accompanied by red LED flashing every 1 second	
Mute	Silent buzzer for 8 minutes	8min ∢ ×
Test	Imitates LED & buzzer pattern as per 'Alarm Mode'	



WARNING

When the power is low, or service life reaches 10 years, the alarm should be replaced. In any doubt, an alarm trigger should be assumed to be due to a fire and appropriate measures must be taken immediately.




Hardwired Install & Device Linking

1) Prepare Wires	Strip the live, neutral and interconnect (if connecting other devices) wires as per diagram 1 shown below
2) Terminals	As per diagram 2, connect the wires to corresponding terminals and ensure terminal screws are properly tightened. Close the terminal cover to avoid contact with live terminals
3) Connect Devices	Devices must be linked together using the interconnect wire
4) Clip to Base	If base is screwed to the ceiling and a battery is installed, the alarms should clip on (this will not work without battery)
5) Testing	A test should be initiated before use (see previous page)
